



CIT Expectations Agreement

In addition to the following all the policies and procedures of the Camp Foster YMCA, as well as complying with the Day Camp Director in all matters, all CIT participants are expected to adhere to the following guidelines:

I recognize that my attitudes, words, and actions are critical to the success of camp, and I promise to do my best in living up to the following guidelines:

1. I understand that safety is always the top priority at camp, and I promise to make good choices that protect the physical and emotional safety of me and all the other campers.
2. I recognize that I am a role model to all the other campers, and I agree to reflect the YMCA Character Values of Caring, Honesty, Respect, Responsibility, and Fairness.
3. I will be sensitive to the needs and interests of each camper, and I agree to support them in making new friends, developing self-respect, learning new skills, and having fun.
4. I will be sensitive to the needs and interests of each CIT participant and staff member, and I will treat them with caring, honesty, respect, fairness, and courtesy.
5. I will take responsibility for keeping all camp equipment and facilities clean and in good repair, and I will notify the Day Camp Director of any unsafe or broken equipment.
6. I will be responsible for my personal belongings and equipment, and I will not hold Camp Foster YMCA or any other person responsible for missing or damaged belongings.
7. I will be on time to camp every day. If I am sick, I will notify the Day Camp Director by calling his cell phone (712-330-6324) between 7:30 and 8:00 AM. If I need to take a day off, I will submit a written request to the Day Camp Director at least two days in advance.
8. I will complete all my assigned responsibilities, and I will participate in all of the camp activities.
9. I understand that the use of profanity, alcohol, tobacco, and drugs will not be tolerated, and that usage during camp will result in immediate expulsion from the CIT Program. Furthermore, I understand that I may not wear clothing that is revealing, contains tobacco/alcohol/drug references, or has inappropriate/suggestive pictures/words.
10. I understand that if I bring a cell phone to camp, I will use it at designated times and places only.
11. I understand that I will not be allowed to have visitors at camp.

I understand that if I do not abide by the guidelines listed above, the Summer Day Camp Director will expel me from the CIT Program, notify my parents/guardians, and send me home immediately.
